b. What is the traditional meal on Christmas Day IN THIS COUNTRY'S LANGUAGE?

c. What is this traditional meal made of?

6. (8 pts.) Find the slideshow about children of this country. There is a picture of a boy outside with his eyes closed and he is doing something. What is this boy doing?

7. (10 pts.) This country used to be tied to Denmark. This country's ties with Denmark were fully broken during which war?

8. (10 pts.) a. What is the average life expectancy of males in this country?

b. What is the average life expectancy of females in this country?

9. (30 pts.) a. What is this country's index rank in gender inequality?

b. This low of a ranking means that males and females are treated more equally in this country that in most of the other countries on that table. The countries with even LOWER rankings are ALL from which continent? c. The country with a ranking of 104 in gender equality is on a different continent than our Round #6 country.
